# Maths Equipment

All children in Year 7 and Year 8 need to have specific equipment for Maths and Science lessons:

#### A scientific calculator:

Our preferred model is the <u>Sharp EL-W531</u> as this offers all of the features required for Common Entrance and beyond (although any scientific calculator will do). Each year the school orders a quantity of Sharp calculators which may be purchased for cost price of approximately £8.50. If you would like to purchase one for



your child, please contact Mr Davis by <u>Saturday</u> <u>15th September</u> and the cost can be added to your school bill.

#### A geometry set:

Pupils require a geometry set which includes at least a protractor and pair of compasses. If possible, pupils should have a 360° protractor as this is very useful for bearings and pie charts work.



#### Other equipment:

In common with most other subjects, pupils also require lead pencils, a 30cm ruler (preferably clear plastic), a glue stick and scissors.

#### <u>Literacy</u>

To recognise the phonemes: s a t i and begin to apply this knowledge when reading simple words.

<u>Mathematics</u> To recognise and count numbers to ten.

#### Year One

<u>English</u>

To write simple sentences, making phonetic attempts at spelling.

#### Mathematics

To investigate numbers 1-4. To solve simple addition and subtraction problems using these numbers.

#### Year Two

<u>English</u>

To begin to plan and write sequences of sentences to tell the story of The Great Fire of London.

#### **Mathematics**

To recognise the place value of each digit in a two digit number (tens, ones)

To identify, represent and estimate numbers to 100 using different representations including the number line.
