Summer Uniform Reminder

May we remind all parents that children should now be in Summer Uniform. Girls up to and including Year 6 should be in summer dresses* and short white ankle socks. Girls in Year 7 and 8 school kilts*, short sleeved white shirt* and short white ankle socks.

Boys up to and including Year 6 should be in short sleeved blue shirt (polo shirt for Pre-Prep), grey shorts* long grey school socks* and school tie. Boys in Year 7 and 8 long grey trousers*, long or short sleeved white shirt and tie*.

Jumpers* and blazers* may be worn if required and will be needed in good condition for formal occasions this term (with the exception of Pre-Prep).

A school sun hat with a neck flap* is compulsory for Nursery and Reception, school cap* compulsory for Years I and 2 and recommended for Year 3 upwards.

Items marked * must be purchased from the school shop at Repton, apart from the Summer Dresses which need to be ordered. (Forms available from the Foremarke School Office or Pre- Prep School office)

The Foremarke Racing F24 Greenpower team will be making their first outing of the 2015 race season this Sunday at the Goodwood Motor Circuit in W. Sussex.

The team have fifteen new recruits from Y7 and we are particularly delighted to see that for the very first time we have more girls than boys! There are nine girls and six boys to join the existing team of eleven members in Y8.

The Goodwood event will be the very first event of the Greenpower season and will be a Test Day rather than racing. This will give us an opportunity to have the cars checked over by the scrutineers to ensure that all the winter modifications comply with the new race regulations. It will also provide an excellent opportunity for our new team members to familiarise themselves with the three cars we are taking along for the day and to learn some track craft as well as practising driver changes under 'race conditions' as this is where we will win or lose races once the qualifying race season gets under way at this same circuit on June 14th.
