From the Headmaster


Dear Parents

Pre-Prep Learning Objectives Michaelmas Week 3

Reception

Literacy:

To recognise the phonemes: p, n, ck, e and apply this knowledge when reading simple words.

Mathematics:

To recognise, count and correctly form numerals to ten.

Year One:

English

To write a simple set of instructions, using capital letters and full stops.

Mathematics

To know the value of each digit in a 'teens' number. To know which is more or less of two numbers.

Year Two

English

To demarcate sentences using capital letters at the start and full stops.

To begin to proof-read to check for errors in spelling, grammar and punctuation.

Mathematics

To add on ones to a two-digit number without crossing over a tens number e.g. 23+4

To recognise number bonds to ten e.g. 9+1=10, 8+2=10, 7+3=10, 6+4=10, 5+5=10 and begin to know them off by heart.

1940's Day and Lower School Football Tournament

Friday 25th September will be an exciting day at Foremarke as we celebrate our 75th anniversary. Lower School will be taking part in some special 1940's themed activities during the first part of the morning before our much anticipated Lower School Football Tournament which will start at 11am. As it is such a special occasion, there will be much press coverage and many photos taken and we would like Lower School children to feature in these and so are asking for the children to come to school dressed as a typical boy or girl from that era, in line with the children in both PrePrep and Upper School.

Tug of War

On Monday 14th September the Inter House Tug of War competitions are scheduled to take place. Years 3, 4 and 5 will take part in the Junior event starting at 4.15pm on Walled Garden (the field by the Pre Prep building) and finishing at 5pm.

Although not compulsory, we strongly encourage all Lower School children to participate as it is good fun and, as the first school competition of the year, it helps to foster their House spirit. It is a good idea for children to bring in a pair of gloves and they will need to have their House shirt in school with the rest of their PE kit. Parents are very much encouraged to come along and support.

At the end of the competition all children must de-reg from the Lower School reception area and can go home in their sports kit, taking uniform with them. There will be no other activities on this evening and there will be no set prep. For those children who need to stay in school until 6pm, junior tea will be provided and de-reg will be from Portico steps as normal.

Lower School Parents' Curriculum Evening

This event will take place next Friday, 18th September, in the theatre and will provide an overview of life and routines in Lower School, plus subjects and topics covered during these early Key Stage 2 years.

It is a good opportunity to come along and meet your child's Form teacher and other parents, and to find out the answers to any questions you might have. Following the presentation, there will be canapés and drinks in the Assembly Hall, organised by the Friends of Foremarke.

Changes to Sports Fixtures on our web site

Please note that we have launched a new **Sports Fixture Module** on our web site. Now you can access the term's fixtures from the Home Page of our web site in **one click** from your computer or any mobile device.

Simply click on the circular tennis racquet and hockey stick icon or the words "Sports Fixtures" on the right hand side of the white panel on the home page.

A full list of the term's fixtures will then display in date sequence. You can use the "filter by" tab at the top of the screen to filter by sport and by teams if you require.

Click on the arrows on the left hand side to expand the fixtures when there are multiple teams playing on the same day.

Use the arrow on the right hand side next to "More info" to see the team list, any further details and a google map of the venue if the fixture is away.

Once a fixture has been played you can see the match report by clicking on the "Results" tab.

You will note that there is a rolling banner at the very top of the page where we will highlight any fixtures that have been added or any changes that are not in the printed calendar.

Please note we will not be printing sports fixture changes in the Foremarke Flyer so if your child plays for a team please do make sure you check the online fixtures each week for up to date information. Thank you.
