Additional Achievements Over the Past Year

- Following the 75th Anniversary Ball, the Friends of Foremarke were able to make a donation of £3000= to Rainbows Hospice (Loughborough) at a special school assembly in June 2016 – Victoria Smith and I attended and presented a jumbo cheque.
- Considering communication, we are now sending out all-school emails, to ensure that everyone (who has formally consented to us having their details) is informed about all Friends of Foremarke events and activities. We now also have foremarke.org.uk email addresses for the four committee Officers (Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, Treasurer); these can be readily passed on when someone vacates a role.
- To help include those who have not been involved with the Friends of Foremarke before, we have created a number of 'event templates' to describe the necessary steps in organising individual events *e.g.* Coffee Mornings.
- We are now liaising with School Council (*via* Mrs Kelly, Deputy Head Pastoral) and the boarding pupils (*via* Mrs Hill, Head of Boarding) in order to find out the sorts of events and 'value-added' items for school that pupils themselves may like.

The Way Ahead

- We have considered, but not yet actioned, creating an online survey to scope the ideas of parents on Friends of Foremarke events and potential 'value-added' items for the school.
- The Friends of Foremarke constitution requires review and revision; the early stages of this process have been intiated, but much more work is needed.
- A 'home' for the Friends of Foremarke is an ongoing matter for discussion, both in terms of somewhere parents can meet (for Friends of Foremarke business but also to socialise) and somewhere to safely and securely store *e.g.* refreshment stock.
