The foremarke.org.uk email addresses for the four Committee Officers (Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, Treasurer) proved to be troublesome, but everyone seems to be able to get hold of us when they need us, using our own email addresses.
- Work has continued on the Friends of Foremarke 'event templates' (describing the
 essential steps in organising individual events) and it is hoped that these will be
 completed next year, to help those who have not previously been involved with the
 Friends if they wish to volunteer their input only two remain to be done.
- We have continued to liaise with School Council (*via* Mrs Kelly, Deputy Head Pastoral) and the boarding pupils (*via* Mrs Hill, Head of Boarding) to find out about events and 'value-added' items for school that pupils themselves may like.
