This is a predominantly term time only position, although there is a clean down and clean up requirement at the beginning and end of each term.

1. You will be employed as a Domestic Cleaner.
2. You will be directly responsible to your supervisor.
3. Your duties will include, but not be limited to the following:
 - 3.1 Emptying waste bins or similar receptacles, transporting waste material to designated collection points.
 - 3.2 Sweeping floors with brushes and mopping floors with wet or damp mops.
 - 3.3 Suction cleaning carpeted areas and "spot" cleaning carpets.
 - 3.4 Using electrically powered scrubbing/polishing machines to burnish, scrub, polish and spray clean floors (after receiving proper instruction and training).
 - 3.5 Dusting, damp wiping, washing or polishing furniture, desks, ledges, window sills, and external surfaces of cupboards, radiators, shelves and fitments.
 - 3.6 Replenishing consumable items (soap, toilet rolls, paper towels)
 - 3.7 Cleaning toilets, urinals, hand basins, sinks, baths and showers, drinking fountains.
 - 3.8 Using such chemical cleaners as directed by the supervisor in the discharge of cleaning operations or maintenance procedures (after receiving proper instruction and training).
 - 3.9 Washing walls or cleaning inside window panes to a height no greater than body height plus an arm's extension from floor level.

- 3.10 All such other duties as the School may reasonably from time to time communicate either orally or in writing to you.
- 3.11 Cleaning of the Pre-Prep, D&T, Music and French and other areas within School. You may also at times be required to provide cover in the Dining Room area and Boarders Tea.
- 4. Your normal hours will include 4.00pm – 7.30pm (or earlier/later by agreement) Monday to Friday.
- 4.1 Variable hours, as agreed with your Supervisor, during the clean-down and clean-up periods at the end of one term and the start of another.
- 5. The **current hourly rate of pay is £8.98**. You will also receive statutory holiday pay.
